

Brooke Tuley & The Moon Travelers

Brooke Tuley writes songs that feel like memories you've almost forgotten — warm, poetic, and honest enough to make you pause and listen again. Rooted in the DIY scene of Kansas City, her music drifts between Americana and dreamlike indie rock, where heartache, hope, and resilience share the same breath.

A lifelong musician and educator, Tuley has been shaping sound and story since her teens — from punk basements and experimental projects to the intimate, reflective songs she now releases under **Brooke Tuley & The Moon Travelers**. Her earlier four-track recording *First Midnight* revealed a raw, homespun voice in transition. *Chase Me*, her latest full-length, expands that voice into a lush, collaborative landscape recorded over fifteen months in the basement studio (Purple Sky Blues) she shares with her husband and longtime collaborator Mike Tuley.

Alongside the album, Tuley released *Chase Me — A Visual Collection of Art, Poetry, and Movement*, a companion book organized by track listing. It pairs her lyrics, poems, and photographs with original work from artists and writers connected to Kansas City, Lawrence, and Wichita, deepening the world of the album and offering listeners a tactile way to experience her storytelling.

At its heart, **Brooke Tuley & The Moon Travelers** is a collaboration-led project guided by Brooke Tuley's songwriting and vision. Each recording brings together a rotating circle of collaborators, allowing the music to reflect the people and moments that shape it.
