Overview

Chase Me is the companion to the album by Brooke Tuley & The Moon Travelers — a collection of art, poetry, and movement created alongside the music. Each chapter follows a track from the record, pairing lyrics with photographs from Brooke's life with artwork from the book. Together, they create a portrait of creativity, resilience, and community — a story told through sound, image, and movement.

Release Context

The book was first shared in May 2024 at a release show in a historic one-room schoolhouse on the prairie. As the sun set, the band played the album in full, and the pages were revealed. The gathering became a moment of release and healing — a quiet celebration of collaboration, reflection, and life's cycles.
